# City GOP endorses slate of incumbents for November election

SARATOGA SPRINGS — The Saratoga Springs Republican Committee named its candidates for city offices in the upcoming election, endorsing all of the GOP incumbents in City Hall.

Incumbents Mayor Scott Johnson, Public Works Commissioner Anthony “Skip” Scirocco, Finance Commissioner Kenneth Ivins, Public Safety Commissioner Richard Wirth and Supervisor Matthew Veitch were all endorsed Monday after the committee filed its nominating petitions.

“Our endorsed candidates will be running on their records of accomplishment,” GOP Committee Chairman John Herrick said. “During our petition drive, the feedback from the taxpayers was extremely positive concerning our candidates.”

In order to appear on a ballot, parties are required to receive signatures from citizens in relation to the number of voters registered in their party.

The Republicans were required to get 353 signatures, according to Saratoga County Commissioner of Elections William Fruci.

According to Herrick, they obtained more than 900 signatures.
